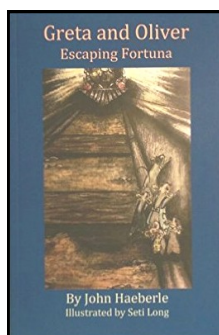
Amaya and Laura are having fun at our birthday party in November. The club has meetings twice a month with a birthday party celebration each month for club members.
